- 1. Turn on the Toggle switch on the FT IR instrument itself. The computer should be on when you come in to use the FTIR.
- 2. open the FTIR icon.
- 3. click on measure
- 4. click on measurement
- 5. click on initialize

- 7. on the right under the data tab:

Happ-Genzel # scans = 4 (use more if your spectrum looks like nothing is in the sample) Resolution = 2.0 Range = 400 to 4000

- 8. click on BKG (you will see # of 4 scans until you get 4 of 4 scans when it finishes) (This should be done with nothing in the sample compartment)
- 9. click on measure check to see if you have the same numbers as shown in 7 above (Load sample in sample compartment )
- 10. click on sample (You will see # of 4 scans until you get 4 of 4 scans when it finishes)
- 11. click manipulate #1 peak table set threshold to where the real peaks are located on the %T scale calculate (to see what it looks like) OK (to save the picked peaks)
- 12. do print preview it will ask you to choose template, choose <u>templateJHahn</u> do print form
- 13 do save as and name file as your initials date notebook page Ex: JMH-52908-34
- 14. under file do export to save onto a USB drive save name in the same format as above
