  - c. safety shower
  - d. fire extinguisher

  - a. If you splash concentrated hydrochloric acid (or base) on yourself (your body, your eyes), what should you do? (3 pts)
  
  - b. If you catch yourself (your clothes or hair) on fire what should you do? (3 pts)
  
  - c. When are you allowed to not wear safety glasses (including safety glasses over head like a headband) while in lab? (i.e. Under what circumstances would you not lose technique points while not wearing safety glasses in lab? (specifically when at start lab & at end lab) (2 pts)
