The grading scale will be the standard grading scale. 90 % & above A, 80 % & above B, etc. The letter grade will never be curved to give a lower letter grade than the standard (i.e. 80% will not be considered to be a C). I do sometimes stretch the lower limits (below C) to your advantage.

**NOTE:** There are no make up quizzes or make up exams. If you give me hardcopy documentation, I will average and plug in a grade. I will drop 2 lowest quiz grades and one exam will be replaced by the final exam.
